#### Introduction

The political analyst asked why the 45<sup>th</sup> US President had nothing to say against his cohorts that had testified against him in his election fraud conspiracy trial (AKA, *the hush money trial*). Being the type of person he is (responding with harsh words against *any* one who harms or speaks against *him*), the quick answer to the question was, Whatever these two know must be *much* worse than what has come out in this *falsified business records/election fraud conspiracy trial*.

The testimony of these witnesses during the recent trial was probably the most damaging to the 45<sup>th</sup> US President. And yet, he has shown no restraint in witness- and jury- tampering and intimidation in relation to the former porn star and his former attorney/fixer, as well as Court officials, their staff, and families, those in a position to put the 45<sup>th</sup> US President *in prison*.

And I said to myself, *They know about the master conspiracy*. *Master conspiracy*, I silently asked, wondering, *Where did that come from?* 

Think about it, Holly, I thought, Do you honestly believe the catch-and-kill conspiracy hatched in the August 2015 Trump Tower meeting, involving the 45<sup>th</sup> US President, et al. was the "point" of all the coverup effort? Yes, it was just indeed legally adjudicated to be a conspiracy to commit election fraud.

The point was to get him elected President of the United States, right? Then what?

What if the "hush money" payment was a *corollary* to another over-arching agreement or *covenant*. He was *already* running to become the 45<sup>th</sup> US President at the time of this meeting, so there was some original agreement or covenant in place to even make *that* happen. The point of the "hush money payment" was to put out a fire that could extinguish election hopes; and the *catch-and-kill conspiracy* was a plan to hedge against future threats and keep the *over-arching* agreement from getting derailed.

So, there's some master conspiracy that no one knows about? I asked, At least, there's not been any reporting to this effect.

The master conspiracy is to overthrow the will of God almighty, I thought, finally understanding the significance of Genesis 9:27, and Daniel 2:44-45. The master conspiracy is to thwart the end of the worldwide domination of Japheth (i.e., Gentile world rule), that *is*, the perpetual subjugation of his brothers, Shem and Ham. The attempt to overthrow the will

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of God *is* tantamount to destroying the seat of government or the *sanctuary* (or *justice*) and thereby, our *nation*, that proudly sits atop the system of laws; similar to how the *mercy seat* sat atop the ark of the covenant or testimony (or the *Law*). The biblical scriptures were starting to make a kind of sense, as if being *reordered* in my mind.

The election of someone with the 45<sup>th</sup> US President's temperament would be helpful to the goal of a "perpetual" time of the Gentiles, I thought. This has the fingerprints of the Russian President all over it.

"Europe has investigated the ascendency of far-right leaders, and *their* association with Russian money. Has US law enforcement been as diligent?"

Probably, in the last week or so, I thought cynically, with a perspective of American history and being an African-American. A good deal of law enforcement at all levels (many of whom are from among the poor of sons of Japheth) view enforcement of the law as being against the children of Ham, who they deem to be the enemy to Gentile civilization.

They have focused over much on the surface for a very long time, refusing to go further than skin-deep, and truly dispense justice among their own kind. Now, they are too late – corruption has run amok. And now, law enforcement finds itself under attack from its own kind. Witness: the January 6<sup>th</sup> capital insurrection and attack on law enforcement; and the Project 2025 documented plan to overthrow the justice department.

Daniel described that final Gentile power as a little horn<sup>1</sup>. Perhaps, due to its youth and immaturity, I thought.

*You know*, I asked myself, *that August 2015 date sounds very familiar*. Later, when checking my notes, I had written about *August 2016*, in 2021, when proposing the date of the beginning of the 70<sup>th</sup> week by counting backwards from the establishment of the abomination of desolation, February 5, 2020.

Well, I thought in some disappointment, that screws up my whole theory. And, if there's some master conspiracy... that would go even further back, timewise... That really, really screws up my whole 70<sup>th</sup> week proposal!

Holly, remember the approach you took in teaching Daniel 9:24-27<sup>2</sup>?

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Many cities or nations, of that time, had their own calendars. So, trying to make the existing calendar work cannot and will not be accurate. Instead, look at the *markers* that are being called out in the scripture.

- 1. Rebuilding the temple in Jerusalem,
- 2. Messiah being cut off,
- 3. Establishment of the abomination of desolation in the middle of the 70th week.

Don't try to make the calendar, as understood now, try to fit this prophecy.

There is *another* marker – "...confirm a covenant with many for a week..." But such a marker may not be seen by all, especially if it's a conspiracy.

## The Master Conspiracy

Daniel 9:27 describes a covenant that will be made prior to the commencement of the final week of the 70 weeks prophecy, outlined in the book of Daniel, "...he shall confirm a covenant with many for a week..."

As noted in the introduction, the "master conspiracy" is the plan to overthrow the will of God, which is the eventual end of Gentile power worldwide.

The time of the Gentiles was kicked off by a dream that God had given to the Babylonian king, Nebuchadnezzar, that he couldn't understand, *no one* could understand it, not even the *Chaldeans* (a tribe of visionaries and interpreters of dreams in the royal court), because Nebuchadnezzar couldn't *remember* it, and hence, the lives of all the *wisemen* in Babylon, including Daniel and his cohorts, were at risk!

Daniel 2:37-45 is the interpretation of that dream, explained by Daniel, that God almighty was conferring dominion in the earth upon Nebuchadnezzar, which was the beginning of the *time of the Gentiles*.

The prophecy proceeds to use metals to describe the subsequent Gentile powers that will succeed the Babylonian kingdom. Over the timeline, with each succeeding power, the quality of metal decreases, down to the mixture of clay and iron in the toes. God is quite clear in describing the future of Gentile dominion: "And in the days of these kings shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not

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be left to other people, but it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand for ever.

"Forasmuch as thou sawest that the stone was cut out of the mountain without hands, and that it brake in pieces the iron, the brass, the clay, the silver, and the gold; the great God hath made known to the king what shall come to pass hereafter: and the dream is certain, and the interpretation thereof sure."

The time of the Gentiles, though enlarged, is finite.4

There is a section of scripture (that the Scofield King James Version<sup>5</sup> of the Bible describes as "Noah's sin") in which the time of the Gentiles is extended. Noah was humiliated to learn that all his *awesomeness* had been discovered by his sons, when he awoke from his drunken slumber, and his naked body had been covered with a garment. Noah was specifically angry with Canaan (Ham's first born), knowing that he had gone *blabbing* about the family leader's drunken state of deshabille, and he spoke a prophecy over his sons, *cursing* Canaan and consigning him to servitude to his brothers, Shem and Japheth.

Understanding these two prophecies in which the *time of the Gentiles* was introduced and that time defined, Daniel 9:24-27 provides the believer – those who are *looking* – a *timeline* of the events that will be witnessed at the end of the time of the Gentiles. God would not allow Noah's curse on Canaan (and thereby Ham) to stand – the time of Japheth would *not* be infinite, *nor* would the servitude of Ham be perpetual. That is not *justice*.

Yet, the *master conspiracy* is just that, a plan and covenant among many to make the Gentile time of rule *infinite*, and the servitude of Ham, *perpetual*.

Please note that Daniel 9:24-27 is *not* describing the end of the *world*, only the end of the *time of the Gentiles*. The disingenuous conflate the two, in their attempt to confuse people. It is noteworthy that the *first* tool the *disingenuous* use to create confusion is to "...cast the truth to the ground..." and make a *practice* of doing so. The second tool, *fear*, will only work so long at maintaining confusion – eventually people get a clue.<sup>7</sup>

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So, what are the *disingenuous* trying to accomplish in that window of time? A thief comes to steal, kill, and destroy<sup>8</sup>, those that are disingenuous do not come honestly, they are *thieves*, come to take something from "the people". If a thief comes to steal, kill, and destroy, then what belongs to "the people" is *valuable*; it is *alive*; it is *just* and *right*. It is a *gift from God!* 

Genesis 1:26 says the children of Adam – "the people" – have dominion over the earth.

Imagine the whole earth as a single nation, the United States of America. *The people* have citizenship in a nation that has a system of justice that is not synonymous with *monarchy*. *The people* have a recourse to get justice, should they suffer an offense. *The people*, as citizens of that nation, have the *authority* to support themselves and their families, which is *how* Adam takes dominion in the earth<sup>9</sup>.

The people have power, position, and authority with God almighty. They have a *crown!* What do thieves have? Surely *not* power, position, and authority with God<sup>10</sup> because they are disingenuous, they *lie!* 

Daniel 9:26 describes how some of the people become the "... people of the prince that shall come..." and how they "shall destroy the city and the sanctuary..." and Daniel 9:27 says that that "...prince that shall come..." will confirm a covenant with *many* for a week. The people of the prince that shall come – the *many* – will be in *alignment* with the prince's attitude and intent, which is to bring destruction upon the nation and its seat of government.

While the master conspiracy is an attempt to overthrow the prophesied end of Gentile world rule, I submit that this was manifested in a covenant the 45<sup>th</sup> US President made with *many* (62,980,000 voters<sup>11</sup>, to be exact), to be the face of the *rebellion*, or to overturn the government or "deconstruct" the administrative state"<sup>12</sup>, in the United States of America – the very *seat* of democratic government for the *final* Gentile power. The 45<sup>th</sup> US President's words and actions found *affinity* in the hearts of the *many*, but *not* the majority<sup>13</sup>.

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So recall, "the people" *have* something that the thieves *want* to steal (kill, if they can't steal it; destroy, if they can't kill it):

- 1. The people have citizenship in a nation that has a system of justice that is *not* synonymous with *monarchy*.
  - The 45<sup>th</sup> US President (whose own sojourn in the US began with a grandfather who bought a one-way ticket to the US, *dodging* the draft in Germany in 1885<sup>14</sup>), along with his *many*, seek to proscribe and *nullify* the citizenship of others *within* the US.
- 2. The people have a recourse to justice, should they ever suffer an offense.
  - The 45<sup>th</sup> US President, along with his *many*, corruptly seek to cut off from that justice system those seeking asylum; those attempting to vote (i.e., *choose* who rules over them); those attempting, including those even *helping*, to redress inequities; those attempting to enfranchise their rights (including the right to *bodily autonomy*) as full citizens of that nation.
- 3. *The people*, as citizens of the nation, have the *authority* or right to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness.
  - The 45<sup>th</sup> US President, along with his *many*, seek to *dictate* and undermine justice by enforcing a *minority*-rule government upon the majority. This is *not* democracy.

The people of *the prince that shall come* agree with the thoughts and desires of the prince that shall come, and hence, these 62,980,000 supporters are representative of those who feel they have *no skin in the game* of a healthy, functioning, *successful* nation and government. These ones will be *thieves* in:

- An electoral college system that dilutes the will of the citizens in a democracy.
- An executive system who's motives are corrupt.
- A legislative system that advances corrupt laws, policies, and practices.
- A judicial system that "throws out" the will of the citizens in a democracy.
- An education system that teaches lies to its citizens in a democracy.
- A religious system that closes its eyes and covers its ears to the transgressions being committed against *every* citizen, of *every* nation.
- A media system that ignores and suppresses and covers its mouth at the injustice committed against the citizens in a democracy.

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- An economic system that seeks to take for itself all it can get, without caring for the people, citizens of the democracy, who are its engine.
- Enemies, foreign and domestic, who have common cause with thieves.
- A hijacked government that leaves its citizens a prey to every enemy<sup>15</sup>.

Daniel 11:30 describes a willful king who will "...have indignation against the holy covenant... he shall even return, and have intelligence with them that forsake the holy covenant..." It is noteworthy that the willful king hates righteousness or justice himself, and will conspire with those who turn their backs on justice, i.e., traitors to justice. These traitors who have had access to and have enjoyed the blessings of justice, are the first to break faith, not those who have begged for and have been denied justice for generations, centuries.

The *master conspiracy* involves *many*, according to the prophecy, not just the *sorry* group of people at the August 2015 Trump Tower meeting. The master *conspirators*, who bring desolations upon the nation and seat of government, are from every level and group of people that hold any power in the nation. They are *traitors*.<sup>16</sup>

#### Conclusion

The picture that biblical scripture paints of what has been seen, what is being seen, and what will be seen is explained in this paper, and the antagonists' motives have been uncovered. What is left to understand?

What could *possibly* cause some of *the people*, the "many", those blessed with so much, to throw their blessing away? What could possibly bring such different groups of people together in one accord, overcoming each other's moral and social inhibitions, to act with one heart and one mind *against* one's *own* interests, to overthrow one's *own nation*? What could possibly do this?

#### 1. Ignorance.

Ignorance, defined as not having knowledge or understanding of a certain thing, carries the connotation of innocence. While it is possible for an ignorant person to be *duped* or *tricked*

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into accepting a policy or making choices against one's own interest, innocence does not apply in the instance of a *willfully* ignorant person.

Recently, a friend contacted me feeling deeply disappointed to learn that one of his favorite TV and radio pastors sponsored a fund raiser for the 45<sup>th</sup> US President in Los Angeles the day before. One would have to be living under a rock somewhere to *not* know about the 45<sup>th</sup> US President's virulent hatred of Black people. So, for a pastor, in complete contravention of the laws of God<sup>17</sup> (from Who's hand he earns a living), to host an event to raise money to propel a man of the 45<sup>th</sup> US President's ilk to the position of President of the United States *again*, would make any claim to innocence on the part of this pastor (by disagreement or by ignorance) moot.

This pastor's heart *aligns* with the 45<sup>th</sup> US President's attitude and policies toward thievery and subjugation of people, and he supports the 45<sup>th</sup> US President's proposed policy actions, including those that are virulently *racist*. Any so-called *ignorance* in this case is *willful*.

### 2. Self-aggrandizement.

History is rife with stories of those who sold themselves out for the fleeting opportunity to gain position and or power. The Bible tells us the story of king Ahab and Jezebel (1 Kings 21), who used their power and position to steal coveted land from his neighbor. And the story of Judas Iscariot, who sold his own salvation for 30 pieces of silver. And today, the story of the congressman who sold-out his heritage, with a *sorry* justification of "Jim Crow", in order to gain a position in a possible *future* administration of a *racist* 45<sup>th</sup> US President. President.

#### 3. Hatred of one's brothers.

What exactly was "Noah's sin" according the translators of the Scofield KJV Bible? Was it passing out drunk in his own tent, or was it cursing his own son? Would Noah regret his words, and the pain and misery suffered by his children, to this very day?

#### Who knows?

What *is* known is that hatred of one's brother has been a dependable and effective tool for creating confusion, distraction, and even death among those tasked with being fruitful and

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multiplying, and taking dominion in the earth.<sup>21</sup> Who benefits from confusion, distraction, and death? *Thieves*. Thieves have used hatred of one's brother as a throughline in each of the examples presented for why some of *the people* – the *many* – would act against their *own interest*, which *is* taking dominion in the earth.

So, if there is dismay at all the anger and *ethnic* animus witnessed in the world today, remember your *scriptures*, and *who* it describes as benefitting from the chaos, *thieves!* 

Have you wondered why men have been running around like *craven* animals with guns, slaughtering Black people, trying to provoke a *race war*? The world is *not* ending, no matter how loudly the *thieves* scream otherwise. God's promise is to establish Adam's *everlasting* kingdom.<sup>22</sup> The only thing coming to an end is the time of Gentile world domination, which is the reason for the ethnic animus and what motivates their violence. They don't *want* to cede power peacefully, and don't have an *iota* of interest in God's coming kingdom!
