Dear, Mr. President,

Greetings and my very best wishes to you and your precious family!

I watched your interview with George Stephanopoulos last night. Thank you for taking the time to try and reassure your supporters – we of the *weak-kneed-brigade*. (I *continue* to pray God's manifold blessings and strength, especially His strength for this day, upon you.)

After watching the interview, I prayed, and was reminded of the Numbers 16 Bible story about a rebellion that took place among the Levites, against Moses and Aaron's leadership. I wrote a play about it when I was leading the Singles Ministry many, many moons ago. The scripture does not *explicitly* say why Korah and his friends thought to rebel but, in my play, I took the approach that it was Moses and Aaron's advanced age, and Korah and his cohorts' inordinately high opinion of themselves.

I think God reminded me of this story because while Korah and his friends were fixated on being "the leader", God, through Moses and Aaron, was focused on moving the children of Israel to a better place (to their Promised Land), as a *whole*. I am writing to ask you and your family to do what Moses and his family did... to hang in there, to not give up; to continue to serve *thankless* people; to continue to lead us through these Gentile (sons of Japheth, Genesis 10:5) end times, as a whole, not just the US, but the world, too.

You are a believer in God, and have a steady, experienced, and knowledgeable hand.

I recently wrote to pastors of several megachurches/denominations (especially those supporting the 45th US President), reminding them that God does *not* support the perpetual subjugation of people, and that *nowhere* in scripture is Gentile dominion described as perpetual. The world is *not* coming to an end, but the time of the Gentiles is. This is the reason for all the ethnic hatred today.

Daniel 2:36 tells us Nebuchadnezzar was the *beginning* of the Gentile time of dominion in the earth, and the rest of this chapter takes us through to the *end* of the Gentile times in Daniel 2:43, down to the 10 toes that are a mixture of the miry clay and iron, which is a description of the attempt by the divine to mingle itself with mankind (Genesis 3:15), that is, to usurp Adam's dominion. But Daniel 2:44-45 must not be forgotten, it tells us God's direction and *intention*, and that He is leading us to a better place, to our *own* Promised Land.
